

Cookie Policy

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1. Simard OÜ (the “Company”) is using cookies in certain areas of simard.io and glider.travel. Cookies are files that store information on the users’ web browser. This Cookie Policy (“Policy”) provides information on the use of cookies.

2. Cookies, for example, allow the website to recognise the user when a user has visited the site earlier, or help identify which part of the site is the most popular, which parts the users are visiting, and for how long they stay there. By analysing this kind of information, the Company can adjust the website to the needs of users and can provide a more diverse users experience. By the help of cookies, the Company can also ensure that the information that is displayed on a user’s next visit will meet the users’ expectations.
 3. The Company reserves the right to unilaterally modify this Policy with immediate effect after such modification, subject to the limitations provided for by law and the requirements of advance notification to the individuals in due time, if necessary. The Company may modify this Policy, particularly when it is required as a result of changes in the laws, the practice of the data protection authority, business needs or employees’ needs, any new activity involving personal data processing or any newly revealed security exposures, or if it is deemed necessary because of individuals’ feedback. When communicating in relation to this Policy or privacy issues, or otherwise keeping in contact with individuals, the Company may use the contact details of individuals available to the Company in order to get or keep in contact with individuals. Upon the request of an individual, the Company will, for example, send a copy of the latest updated version of this Policy to individuals or certify that a certain individual has read the Policy.
 4. Our site allows the user to agree or disagree to the use of certain cookie sets (see Clause 7). At their first visit of the site and then at regular intervals, users are asked to consent to the use of cookies. Users can change their choice at any time by clicking on the “Cookie Settings” link at the bottom of the page. The website is designed to operate with cookies, whereby disabling them may affect the usability of the website or prevent the user from taking full advantage of it.
 5. The users can configure their web browser to accept all cookies, reject all cookies, or notify the user when a cookie is sent to the user’s computer. Each web browser is different so the “Help” menu in the web browser can help users change cookie settings.
